The quarterly medical check-up with the help of CSA has been organized in both homes. Regular sessions on health and hygiene are organised by para medical staff for all children and staff.

The children committees, Man Ki Bat sharings were the key stages of child participation and sharing. Through the committees, children are into planning and execution of various activities of the CCI. Through Man Ki bat, they come together with management for sharing their ideas, and feedback and evaluating the month to ensure their voice is counted always.
